

EDUCATORS COMPETENCES

The Competence Framework for Educators articulates the competences that Educators need to support learners in developing cultural awareness and expression through arts-based learning. These five competences emphasise adaptive, reflective, and context-sensitive practices that respond to educators' and learners' diverse identities, cultural backgrounds, and requirements.

1. Designing Inclusive and Culturally Responsive Learning Environments

- Creating accessible and welcoming learning spaces.
- Responding to learners' diverse backgrounds and needs.

2. Building Creative Processes

- Supporting learners through creative and cultural processes.
- Gradually fostering learner autonomy.

3. Assessing Cultural and Arts-Based Learning

- Assessing creative and cultural learning processes.
- Using inclusive and context-sensitive assessment approaches.

4. Facilitating Intercultural Dialogue and Collaboration

- Facilitating exchange across cultural differences
- Supporting collaborative processes that enable shared understanding and respectful interaction.

5. Reflecting on Practice and Cultural Positionality

- Reflecting on cultural positioning and bias.
- Adjusting practice to support equity and inclusion.
